Description:	All students in Years K-6 attend the Athletics Carnival at Sylvania Athletics Track.
	Throughout Term 2, all students have participated in the Zing athletics skills program. This program teaches the skills needed for field events:
	*Shot put, discus and long jump - all students aged 8-13 are eligible to compete thigh jump - only students who have indicated consent below specifically in high jump may compete (there will be novelty activities running during this rotation if not competing in high jump). Following the 'Guidelines for the Safe Conduct of Sport and Physical Activity in Schools', students who wish to compete in High Jump MUST HAVE EXPERIENCE AND KNOW EXACTLY WHAT THEY ARE DOING. If using the Fosbury Flop Technique you will need to indicate the qualified instructor who has coached your child or they will be unable to use this style. *Track (100m, 200m, 800m) - open to all students. *1500m - all students aged 8-13 are eligible to compete. If your child would like to compete in this event parents must read the attached information.
	IMPORTANT INFORMATION *K-1 students will commence at 10.00am and conclude by 1.00pm. Buses will transport K-1 students from school at 9.30am and return by 1.30pm. *2-6 students will commence at 9.00am and conclude by 2.30pm. Buses will transport 2-6 students at 8.15am and begin arriving to pick up 2-6 students from the Athletics Track from 2.30pm. Students who get the bus home from school will leave on the first bus from Sylvania Athletics Track. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure the bus returns to school on time, scenarios out of our control such as traffic, buses running late etc, may mean the bus returns to school after our usual end of day bell at 3.15pm. It is highly recommended that any 2-6 students who usually catch the bus home from school make alternate arrangements for this day in case we are running late.
	A program with rough timings for all events will be distributed closer to the event date.

1500m Event 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

As per previous years, NSW PSSA are including the 1500m event for Jnr (8,9/10yrs), 11yrs and Snr (12/13yrs) at the NSW PSSA Athletics Carnival. This event will also be held at the Cronulla Zone Carnival and Sydney East Carnival. At Cronulla Zone level, each school in the zone will submit the two top times from each age division. The top ten times across the zone ONLY will compete in the Cronulla Zone 1500m race. This is consistent with the Sydney East Championship selection process.

Therefore, we will also run this event at our carnival on Tuesday 25th June as the first event of the day, prior to the main carnival starting.

At school level, this event will be offered as an expression of interest to any student who wishes to compete in this event. Students should note the selection process outlined above when making their decision.

The 1500m event will be run prior to the start of our Athletics Carnival. Any student who puts their name down to compete in the 1500m will need to organise private transport to Sylvania Athletics Track and meet Mr Alimbakis and Ms Issa at the track at 8:15am, ready for an 8:25am start.

Please note that costs associated with the carnival are spread evenly amongst all students, and any student competing will still be charged the full bus fee for the day.
