	We suggest students should be picked up by 11.30am to eat, shower and get dressed and RETURN TO SCHOOL BY 12.50PM SHARP. As we are picking up dancers from Sylvania Heights Public School, it is important that the children are not late. The performance itself begins at 6:00pm and will finish around 9.00pm. The doors to the centre will be open at 5:00pm and entry is by prepurchased ticket only. Please note: All students will need a private lift home from the Centre, as the bus is only one way.

Transport:	Seat belted bus to venue (leaving at 1pm from GPPS and picking up students from Sylvania Heights Public School on the way).
Dress Code:	 - Green lycra accessories (bow ties, cummerbunds, chokers, vests and gloves etc) provided by the school. - Ballroom dancing shoes (SEE ATTACHED NOTE). - Full dancing outfit is to be worn on the bus. - Students are to wear or bring our red Grays Point Public School jacket.
	 Boys MUST wear black socks please. Children are to bring a small bag to include their food and drink. Make-up: The girls need to wear full stage make-up (grey eyeshadow & red lipstick) as they will be under bright lights. Hair is being done at school in the morning. Bring lipstick. Non-finalist boys are to wear a black t-shirt (purchased themselves). Finalist boys are to wear a white long sleeve shirt (provided by school). All boys are to wear their hair neat and tidy - off the face. No watches or jewellery. Small studs are fine.

Dear parents and caregivers,

Year 5 are eagerly anticipating their upcoming Ballroom Dancing Performance on Tuesday 27th August (Week 6, Term 3).

In preparation for the performance, Year 5 have been asked to buy ballroom dancing shoes to wear on the night. For those students who have not got a pair of ballroom shoes yet, either on your own or through the Cinderella shoe fitting, please have them purchased by the beginning of Term 3 week 3.

Girls Shoes:

Girls must buy a 'Character' style shoe as seen in the photo below. They are a simple black shoe with a nude-coloured strap and slight heel. They can be plastic/canvas to be affordable or leather for those who desire a more expensive shoe.

Boys Shoes:

Boys must buy a 'Character' style shoe as seen below. It is a simple black laced shoe with a small heel. They can be plastic/canvas to be affordable or leather for those who desire a more expensive shoe.



Both boys and girls 'Character' style shoes can be bought at 'Bloch' or any other affordable shoe shop. You may even consider seeing if there are some second hand shoes available on Facebook Marketplace or Gumtree that match the above descriptions.

Students are also encouraged to bring their shoes to Ballroom Dancing on Fridays when they have purchased them to begin practicing in them.
